# Where are the shelters located?



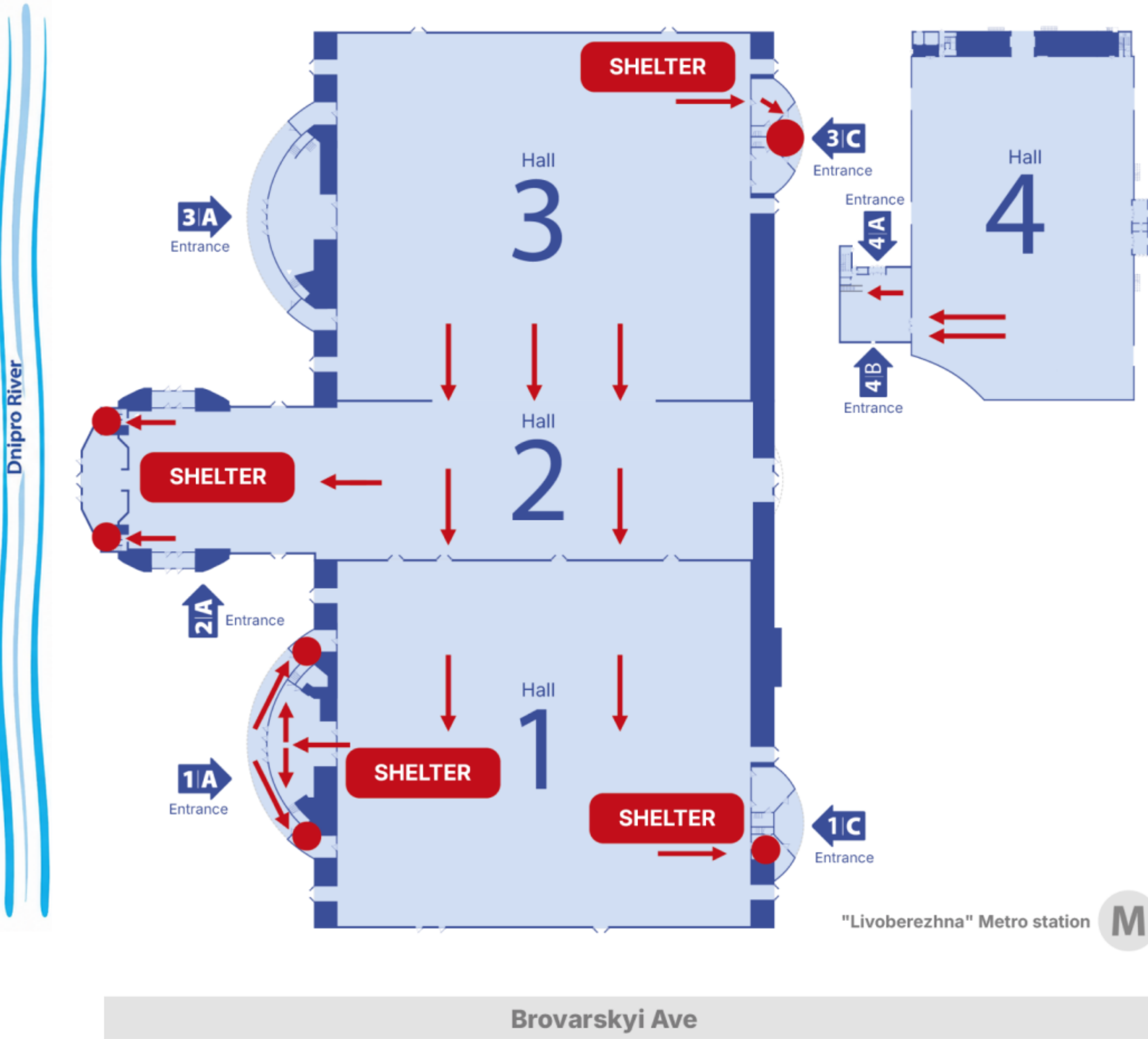
**Civil protection shelters are located on the premises of the International Exhibition Centre (IEC):**

- **Hall 1 — Entrances 1A and 1C**
- **Hall 2 — Entrance 2A**
- **Hall 3 — Entrance 3C**

**Upon arrival at the exhibition, please familiarise yourself with the location of the nearest shelter**

# What should you do when an air raid alert sounds?



**When an air raid alert is announced, the public address system at the International Exhibition Centre will be activated.**

**Please remain calm and pay close attention to all announcements**



# What to do during an air raid alert



- **Follow the instructions** of the organisers and security personnel.
- **Calmly leave your stand** or the place where you were when the alert sounded.
- **Take your documents, personal belongings and badge** with you.



**Your badge is required to re-enter the exhibition**





# How to get to the shelter



**Follow the signs and designated routes to the shelter.**



**If necessary, help and guide those who may have difficulty reaching the shelter on their own**





# Important information during an air raid alert



**During an air raid alert, security personnel monitor the entrances and allow people to exit the exhibition halls. Entry to the exhibition area is temporarily restricted.**

**The shelters on the exhibition centre premises remain open to everyone.**

**You may return to the hall only after the all-clear has been given**





# Returning after the all-clear



- **Exhibitors** must return to their stands within **15 minutes** and present their exhibitor badges.
- **Visitors** will be allowed to re-enter the exhibition **20 minutes** after the all-clear, provided they have their visitor badges.
